THESE INSTRUCTIONS SHOULD BE FOLLOWED WHEN CHECKING EQUIPMENT

- Check the general overall condition and appearance of the equipment including paint finish and signage etc.
- Check all stickers such as Marwood Logo, MGS 24 Plant Return Label, MGS55 • Work platform plate, MGS56 Forklift Instructions, MGS58 Heel Pins, MGS 79 Overhead Hazard, Next Exam Due Date (MGS 71), and Anchor Point Stickers (MGS 90). (Refer to sticker register)
- Check and Record Plant No & Serial No (if present). •
- Check the condition of the main frame for any damage and distortion. Inspect all the body parts of the platform for any sign of pitting corrosion.
- Check condition of all welds thoroughly on the platform. •
- Check condition of the floor looking for signs of overloading, bowed floor. Make sure • if drain holes are present that they are not blocked.
- Inspect fork channels for sign of pitting corrosion, distortion, cracked welds and • damage.
- Inspect retaining pins/ auto fork lock for any sign of damage, twist or distortion.
- Check the condition of the tool box for any damage. •
- If fitted, check thoroughly the anchor point round bar and it must be 12mm diameter. • When transporting the platform using a fork lift, Care must be taken not to damage the

Equipment which displays evidence of incorrect operation or damage should be withdrawn from service and returned to workshops.
